- 2) Direct staff accordingly pursuant to California Elections Code § 10229. Motion carried, 5-0.

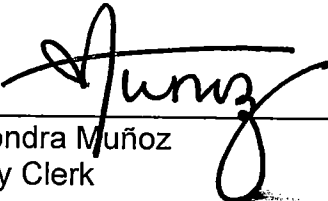

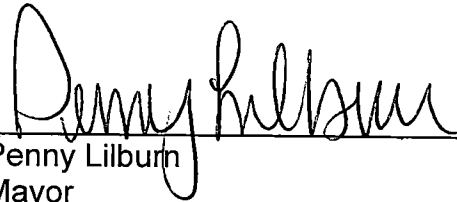
